

Public Information: 2017 Student and Alumni Satisfaction



We believe that **great teachers and school leaders are made** – not born – through the support of educators who are great teachers. Relay’s faculty has demonstrated success in P-12 classrooms and with adult learners.

Our students also recognize the strength of our faculty. Among our students enrolled in teacher programs, **97%** indicated that their Relay faculty was an **effective** instructor as measured by Relay’s 2016 end-of-year student survey. Nearly all (**99%**) indicated that their instructor was knowledgeable.

This impression persists with our alumni. According to the fall 2017 alumni survey, which represents our teachers and school leaders, **91%** affirmed that they were **satisfied with the preparation** they received at Relay. Specifically:

- **98%** are confident that they can measure and analyze student growth and achievement.
- **97%** agree that they can improve their teaching based on feedback and reflection on practice.
- **97%** believe they can set challenging and appropriate goals for student learning and performance.
- **95%** agree that they can maintain a purposeful and effective learning environment.
- **96%** can use knowledge of student learning and curriculum to plan instruction.
- **95%** can provide purposeful feedback to students to guide their learning.
- **95%** agree that they can adapt practice based on research and student data.
